Main Goal

To create seed bombs using natural materials and suitable seeds.

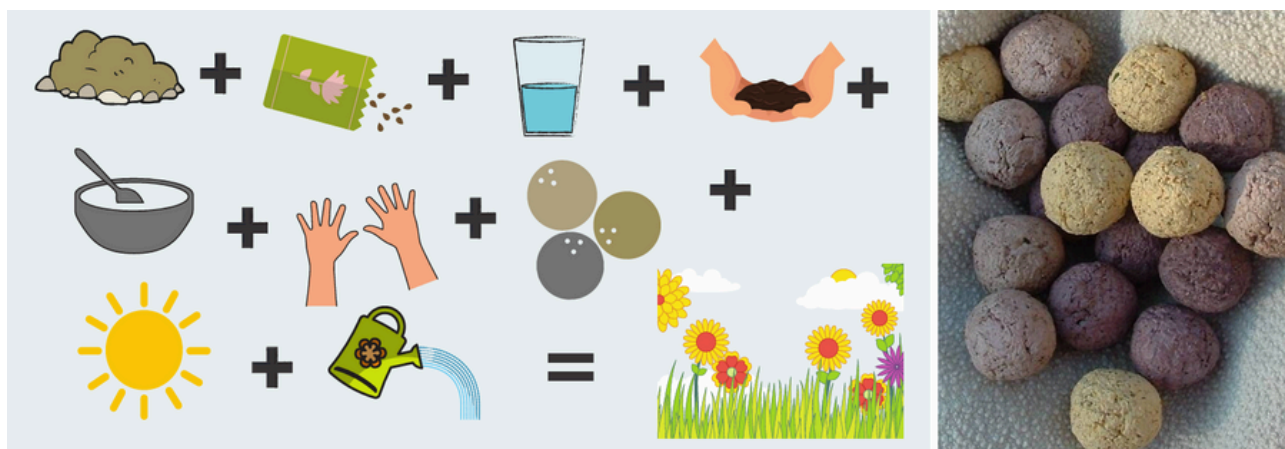
Our seeds:

Supplies:

- clay powder (you can also collect it in nature): it protects the seeds from insects and birds
- water (to add to the clay when the seed bomb is finished)
- seeds
- compost
- tray

Instructions:

Prepare a 5 : 1 : 1 mixture. Mix five parts clay (if you want a colored ball, add a little food coloring) with one part compost, one part seeds and a few drops of water. Knead in your palms, flatten and cut to the desired size. Shape the cut part into a ball and dry in the sun.



How do they work?

Bury the seed bomb just below the surface. In three weeks you will notice the first plants. The seeds will wait until the conditions outside are best for their growth. You can mix one or more types of seeds into the bombs.
